

Progress Report 2024-25





A fruit and broadleaf plantation drive was initiated at the Malori field station on 19th July 2024, followed by second round of plantation in 7th Sepetember during which 100 plants were planted.





A meeting of Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs) was convened on 30th July, 2024 at the MJVS Office, Mandi. The key agenda of the meeting was to deliberate on various aspects of inter-linkages among FPOs, including production, value addition, marketing, and common branding. After detailed discussions, it was unanimously resolved to initiate the formation of a District Federation of FPOs in Mandi District. The federation aims to strengthen both forward and backward linkages among the existing FPOs, facilitating better coordination, resource sharing, and market access.



The organization actively participated in an event organized to promote indigenous industries, with a special focus on supporting handloom weavers. The event was held on 7th August, 2025 at Sryo Handloom and Handicraft Pvt. Ltd., Nandi, in collaboration with NABARD and MSJVS, Mandi. 



पर्यावरण को बचाने के लिए सामाजिक आन्दोलन बना कर पहल करनी होगी: वांग





The visit offered an excellent opportunity to understand the replicable models of community-based technology intervention and women-centric innovation for rural livelihoods.





Society for Technology and Development (STD), Mandi, successfully conducted a two-phase internship/field training programme for MBA (Rural Development) students from Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla, supported by the Department of Interdisciplinary Studies.

A total of 31 first-year students participated in the first 10-day program from 15th to 24th January, 2025, followed by 24 third-year students in the second 10-day program from 2nd to 11th February, 2025. The primary objective of the training was to bridge the gap between academic learning and real-world applications, providing students with hands-on experience in rural development practices.

Key Components of the Internship:

- Expert-led sessions on rural development theories, policies, and innovations.
- Field visits to rural communities to observe development interventions and engage with local populations.

Exposure to agro-processing units, handloom and handicraft clusters, and
interaction with Horticulture and Agriculture University professionals to
understand their role in rural upliftment.

Industry and cooperative visits that provided insights into rural enterprises, SHGs, and sustainable business models promoting livelihood development and

community empowerment.

 Interaction with subject matter experts, enabling students to gain deeper knowledge of ongoing programs and institutional mechanisms in rural development.

This internship program offered a comprehensive learning platform for students to develop a **practical understanding of rural dynamics**, enhance their analytical skills, and appreciate the value of community-based development models.
